TEAMS:

Composed of 3 or 4 riders and a horse manager. If any Club cannot send a complete team, its' individual riders may be placed on a mixed team. Each team may have one C Advisor. **AT LEAST 1 CHAPERONE AND 1 VOLUNTEER MUST ACCOMPANY EACH TEAM.**

ADVISOR:

Must be a current Pony Club member of C rating or above. On the day of the Rally, an advisor may direct, but not actually do the work for the team. The Advisor does not serve as the team's coach.

WRITTEN TEST:

All team members will take a written test. The test may be given orally to very young members at the request of the team captain.

DRESSAGE TEST:

Ridden in a grass arena.

Unrated/D1 2003 USDF Intro A

D2 2003 USDF Intro B or 2002 USEF Novice C

D3 2002 USEF Novice C

There will be a 5 point penalty if tests are read aloud. D2s and D3s riding on the same team must ride tests of the same value (USEF Novice C).

CROSS COUNTRY:

Unrated and D1 1'

D2 2'

D3 2'6"

STADIUM JUMPING:

Heights will be the same as for Cross Country.

HORSE MANAGEMENT: Will be scored throughout the day

ATTIRE:

Correct informal attire per the USPC Horse Management Handbook and Rules for Competition, 2002.

ASTM/SEI approved helmets are required.

Shoes or boots with hard soles that cover the ankle.

AWARDS

- Ribbons will awarded to 10th place. Additionally, there will be trophies for Best Individual Dressage Score and Best Horse Management.

ENTRIES

- \$ 40 per competitor. No fee for C Advisors
- 10 teams accepted on a first come first serve basis
- One team entry form and individual Rally Release, Pony Club Medical Release form, current coggins test and rabies certificate are required.
- CVPC members who have forms on file with the DC need not resubmit.
- Make checks payable to CVPC.

RULES

- DC's, parents and friends are asked to observe the USPC rules regarding unauthorized assistance.

HELP

- **All clubs, please plan to provide fence judges for cross-country.**

FOOD

- **Will be sold on the grounds.**

DIRECTIONS: From I-95 South: Exit 70, at end of ramp go straight through intersection. At 3rd light turn right onto Rt. 156. Go north 2.6 miles. Farm on left.

From 1-95 North: Exit 70, turn left at end of ramp onto Rt. 156, go north 2.6 miles. Farm on left.

From Route 11: Follow Rt. 11 to end. Go right at end of ramp onto Rt. 82, at intersection with Rt. 156 go left. Follow Rt. 156 for 6 miles. Farm on right.
