First Inspection followed by Jog-out: 9:00 a.m.

Teams: Composed of 3 or 4 riders, UR - D3's and 1 non-riding D-level horse manager. Each team may have one C advisor who must be a current Pony Club member of C rating or above. A chaperone **MUST** be sent in with each team or partial team. Single riders and partial teams will be combined to form complete teams when possible. Some horses managers and chaperones may not be needed and in that case, fees will be refunded.

Written Test: Will be given in the morning following the briefing. The test may be read to any member without penalty upon request of the team captain or the member.

Dressage Test: Ridden in a sand arena.

Unrated/D1: 2003 USDF Intro Test A

D2: 2003 USDF Intro Test B or 2002 USEF Novice Test C

D3: 2002 USEF Novice Test C

There will be a 2 point penalty if test are read aloud. D2's and D3's riding on the same team must ride test of the same value (2002 USEF Novice Test C).

Stadium Jumping: Unrated and D1: 1'

D2: 2'

D3: 2'6"

D2 and D3 divisions will compete in an enclosed grass arena. Unrated and D1 will compete in a fenced, sand ring.

Rally Rules: The rally will be according to USPC Rules. Horse Management will be scored throughout the day according to USPC Horse Management Handbook and Rules for Competition 2002. Each team must have these rulebooks and be familiar with their contents.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded through 10th place for overall score and horse management.

Stabling and Tack Rooms: Stalls are not available during the rally. Competitors must use their trailers and the trailering area for horses and tack rooms. All tack rooms should be set up in tents.

Overnight Stabling: Overnight stabling is available at Valley Crest Farm. Competitors are responsible for supplying their own shavings, feed, buckets, hay. Stabling is \$30/night. Please contact Lisa Winkler 845-454-0211 to make arrangements.

Volunteers: Please have 2 volunteers per team prepared to assist with rally duties. Chaperones may be volunteers.

DIRECTIONS TO GONE AWAY FARM

Directions from Connecticut or Westchester

Van & trailers: Rt. 684 North to Brewster exit. Get on Rt. 22 North to Rt. 55 West. Stay on Rt. 55 & pass under Taconic Pkwy. Make a right turn onto Freedom Plains Rd./County Rt. 47 (Mobile gas station on corner). Stay on Freedom Plains Rd. until end, then make a left turn onto R. 44 West (at 2nd traffic light, CVS on right). Make a quick right turn onto West Rd. & stay on West Rd. until it ends. At stop sign, turn right and then take the left onto Gretna Rd. Stay on Gretna Rd. until it ends (lake across the road from stop sign). Go left at stop sign onto Netherwood Rd. and follow around the bend. Make first right onto Marshall Rd. Go 2 miles, when the road forks stay to the right. (This is where Marshall Rd. turns into Browning Rd.) **YOU ARE ALMOST THERE.** Continue short distance on Browning Rd. to parking signs. Follow parking signs. Trailer parking in field on right.

Directions from Rt. 9 South

Vans, trailers & passenger cars: Take Rt. 9 to Rt. 9G north to the East Park traffic light (Mobil station on Southeast corner, Crispell hardware on Northeast corner). Make right onto Crum Elbow Rd., which becomes Netherwood Rd. Go straight through traffic light and make left onto Marshall Rd. Go 2 miles and bear right; Marshall Rd. turns into Browning Rd. **YOU ARE ALMOST THERE.** Continue short distance on Browning Rd. to parking signs.

Directions from Rt. 9 North

Vans, trailers & passenger cars: Take Rt. 9 to Rt. 9G south to the East Park traffic light (Mobil station on Southeast corner, Crispell hardware on Northeast corner). Make left onto Crum Elbow Rd., which becomes Netherwood Rd. Go straight through traffic light and make left onto Marshall Rd. Go 2 miles and bear right; Marshall Rd. turns into Browning Rd. **YOU ARE ALMOST THERE.** Continue short distance on Browning Rd. to parking signs.
