The Ridge Riders Pony Club is hosting another games challenge. The challenge is open to all ages and levels of riders. ASTM/SEI approved helmets are required for all riders. There will be a safety/bit check 30 minutes prior to playing. Teams will be pinned right after their division. Teams are requested to bring PINNYS or wear MATCHING SHIRTS and to have a WHITE HELMET COVER.

The overall judge will be Mark Washburn. The games and equipment will be in accordance with USPC Handbook and Rules for Games Competition 2003. You can find all the rules on height, weight, biting, saddlery, etc. at [www.ponyclub.org/pdfs/rulebooks/games2005.pdf](http://www.ponyclub.org/pdfs/rulebooks/games2005.pdf) and all will be in effect for this competition.

Please send all team entries in together. Also there will be no refunds after the closing date without a medical note. Each team must send in 2 volunteers with there entries. If there are not 2 volunteers list on the form the team will not get to compete.

**Entry Fee:**

\$ 40.00 per person/per division

**Divisions:** Novice, Junior, Senior, Advanced, and Parent/Fossil. The novice division is for all new or inexperienced riders. Canterng will be permitted in the Novice Division but this division is for beginners. Advanced players must be 14 or older. The Parent/Fossil division will be 2-man teams.

**Novice & Parents/Fossil:** Bending, Ball and Cone, Bottle Race, Canadian Race, Carton, 5 Flag, Housewife's Scurry, 3 Mug, Two Flag

**Advanced, Junior & Senior:** Bending, Ball and Bucket, Ball and Cone, Bottle Race, Canadian Race, Carton Race, 5 Flag, Housewife's Scurry, Litter, Rope Race, Stepping Stones, 3 Mug, 2 Flag, Golf Ball and Spoon Race

We will try to get all the games done if time allows. Mug Shuffle will be the tiebreaker for all divisions.

**Directions:**

NY Thruway to Route I-287 South or George Washington Bridge to Route I-80 West. Route I-80 West to Route I-287 South. Exit Route 287 (Exit 22) at Route 206 North (Bedminster). Proceed North on Route 206 towards Pottersville Road (approximately 4.5 miles; 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> light). Continue on Pottersville Road about a mile. The road will go up a hill, and the road will curve towards the left. At the top of the hill, look for a small road on the left- School House Lane (there is a sign for USET there). The road will have speed bumps and there will be a golf course on both sides of the road. Continue down the driveway and go past the driveway to the main barn. Follow the driveway to the HIGH POINT signs. You can park up in the High Point Field.
