Teams: will be of 3 or 4 riding members of mixed ratings. Each team can have a horse manager and an advisor. Incomplete teams will be combined to form mixed teams. The C advisor must be a current Pony Club member of C level or higher. Advisors must be able to supervise the team members regarding safety.

Written Test: All team members will take a written test. The test may be given orally to young team members at the request of the team captain.

Dressage Test: The dressage ring will be in a small sand arena. In the event of large enrollment, a small grass arena may be added.

Unrated and D1 test = 2003 USDF Intro Test A.

D2 test= 2003 USDF Intro Test B or 2002 USEF Novice C

D3 test= 2002 USEF Novice C

5 point penalty if tests are read aloud. D2's & D3's riding on the same team must all ride the Novice C test.

Cross Country: Unrated and D1's will ride an obstacle course, 1'. D2 fences will be in a large enclosed field with maximum heights of 2'. D3's will ride in an open field with 2'6" maximum heights.

Stadium: Heights are the same as X-country.

Horse Management will be scored throughout the day. All teams should have all items from the required equipment list for 1 day rallies.

Attire: Correct informal attire as per the USPC horse management handbook and rules for Rallies. Helmets must be ASTM-SEI approved.

Footwear: Judges, Advisors, Horse Managers and Competitors must wear acceptable footwear such as paddock boots, riding boots, or sturdy, thick soled ankle high shoes. Parent Volunteers (gate keepers, horse holders etc. should also have on appropriate footwear.)

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to each team member for overall placement and horse management.

Volunteers: Each team must have a chaperone and at least one volunteer for fence judging. The more hands, the easier the work!

Manure: should be collected and dumped in the manure spreader.

Food: will be sold on the grounds. Water will be provided for competitors.

Dogs: should be leashed.

Entries: Fee \$30 per rider. No fee for horse managers. Rally will be limited to 10 teams in order of receipt. Entries close Sept. 25th. but please email Ev Brown with your team intentions for planning purposes. Make checks payable to SVPC. Include a rally release and medical release form for every ponyclubber including managers and advisors. Send copies of rabies and Coggins papers for each horse. SVPC members with paperwork already on file should just submit the rally release form. Mail entries to the secretary.
