

Glastonbury Pony Club D/C Rally
Sunday, May 27th, 2007

Babcock Hill Equestrian Center, 456 Babcock Hill Road, Coventry, CT

Rally will be held Rain or Shine

Competition will include Dressage, Stadium Jumping and HM

Teams: Will consist of 3 or 4 riding members of mixed ratings, Unrated thru C-3. If any club cannot send a complete team, individual riders will be placed on a "scrambled" team. Stable Managers are required. Teams with no C-Level Riders are required to have C-Advisors. C-Advisors and Stable Managers must fill out and submit an Entry Form and Medical Release Form.

Advisor: Must be a current Pony Club member of C Rating or above. On the day of the rally, an advisor may offer instruction and keep track of time schedules of events, but must not actually perform tasks for the competitors. The advisor should be capable of supervising the safety of team members and be able to take appropriate action if a team member's safety is endangered at any time during the rally. Lounging of horses may be done, with the approval of the Horse Management Judge, by advisors of a C-2 rating and above, as long as they are supervised. The Stable Manager may not be substituted as a rider, but must be of appropriate age and rating for the rally.

Dressage Test: Unrated and D-1 Riders will ride D1- 2007 USDF Intro Test A

D2- 2006- USEF BN Test A or B

D3- 2006- USEF BN Test A or B

C-Level Riders will choose their Combined Test level

Dressage tests for the levels are as follows:

Beginner Novice - USEF 2006 BN Test B

Novice- USEF 2006 Novice Test A or B

Training- USEF 2006 Training Test A or B

We discourage riders from having the test read aloud, but if necessary there will be a 5 point penalty in the dressage score. D-3 and higher level riders *may not* have their tests read aloud.

Stadium Jumping: Unrated and D-1: Rails on the ground and cavaletti at their lowest setting.

D-2:	2' maximum
D-3:	2'6" maximum
Beg. Novice:	2'7" maximum
Novice:	2'11" maximum
Training:	3'3" maximum

Horse management: Will be scored throughout the day with the emphasis on the formal turnout inspection which will take place approximately one hour before the competitor's scheduled dressage ride. Inspections begin at 8:15.

Helmets: Each competitor must wear an ASTM/SEI Approved hard hat. Helmets will be checked at Tack and Turnout.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to the 1-10 place teams. In addition there will be awards for low scoring horse management scores.

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$50. per rider. The Rally is limited to 14 teams. Entries will close on May 12, 2007 with no exceptions. Checks should be made payable to Glastonbury Pony Club and sent with the individual entry form which must be signed by the parent or guardian, along with a copy of a negative Coggins and Rabies Certificate dated less than one year from the competition and a Pony Club Medical Release Form.

Any horse entering the rally facility must have proof of EHV vaccination within 90 days prior to competition and must have a normal temperature within 72 hours prior to the event. This is a requirement of the facility. Please bring proof with you on the day of the event.

Each team must have a team entry form submitted with contact, trailering and volunteer information. Only one is required per team.

Parking: Grounds Open at 6:30, Rally Competition begins at 7:45. To ensure plenty of set up time, please arrive no later than 7:00. You will be directed to your designated parking place.

Food: Will be sold on grounds. Bottled water will be provided free to competitors throughout the day.

After Wednesday, May 10th, please contact us by email or phone if you have changes in your entry, such as a change in rating, change in horse, etc.
