The Gladstone Games Series will be held this year for the second time. We will be awarding 1-6 places at each competition. This is the final competition of the series and at the end of each division we will award the HIGH POINT year end ribbons. The will be awarded in the Advanced, Junior, and Senior divisions.

We will be holding a games weekend this time around. November 3 will be a clinic and November 4 will be a challenge. Both days are open to all ages and levels of riders. ASTM/SEI approved helmets are required for all riders for both days. There will be stabling available on grounds if needed. There are hotels available in the area. Teams will be pinned right after their division. Teams are to wear PINNYS or wear MATCHING SHIRTS and to have a WHITE HELMET COVER. All rider must also fill out a Medical Release Form and Activity and Rally Release.

Please send team entries in together. Also there will be NO refunds after the closing date without a medical note. Each team must send in 2 volunteers with their entries for the competition day or the team will not be allowed to compete. **USET is no longer requiring the Rhino vaccine.**

Saturday November 3 will be a games clinic with Mark Washburn from Pennsylvania (EPA Region). Mark was a member of the USPC International team in 1980. From 1994-1996, he was a member of the USMGA World Team. He has been involved with mounted games for almost three decades. The clinic will be broken up by riders' games level. You will have the option of riding in 2 sessions if you wish. You can choose if you would like to ride in the AM or PM session and we will try and accommodate your time.

Sunday November 4 we will hold a games competition. This is the last competition of the series and the end of the year awards will be handed out. The games and equipment will be in accordance with USPC Handbook and Rules for Games Competition 2003 and the IMGA Games Rule Book. The IMGA rule book can be found at <http://mountedgames.org/files/IMGARules.pdf> and the pony club rule book [www.ponyclub.org/pdfs/rulebooks/games2005.pdf](http://www.ponyclub.org/pdfs/rulebooks/games2005.pdf) and they all will be in effect for this competition.

Please send team entries in together. Also there will be NO refunds after the closing date without a medical note. Each team must send in 2 volunteers with their entries for the competition day or the team will not be allowed to compete.

Stabling will be \$25 a day. Stabling Friday night is available. You will need to bring your own shavings, hay, and buckets. There is water available in the barn. Please also leave a contact number on the stall. When you leave, stalls will need to be stripped out and swept.

**Directions:**

NY Thruway to Route I-287 South or George Washington Bridge to Route I-80 West. Route I-80 West to Route I-287 South. Exit Route 287 (Exit 22) at Route 206 North (Bedminster). Proceed North on Route 206 towards Pottersville Road (approximately 4.5 miles; 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> light). Make a left onto Pottersville Road. Continue on about a mile. The road will go up a hill, and the road will curve towards the left. At the top of the hill, look for a small road on the left-School House Lane (there is a sign for USET there). Make a left onto School House Lane. The road will have speed bumps and there will be a golf course on both sides of the road. Continue down the driveway and go past the driveway to the main barn. Follow the driveway to the HIGH POINT signs. You can park up in the High Point Field.

**Senior:** Bending, Ball and Bucket, Joust(IMGA), Hula Hoop, Litter Race, 4 Flag (IMGA), Stepping Stones, Sword Race, Ball and Cone, Canadian Race, Carton Race, Tool Box, Ride and Run, Bottle Race, Hi Lo Race, 5 Flag

**Novice:** Bending, Carton Race, Bottle Race, Sword Race, 5 Flag, 4 Flag(IMGA), Ball and Bucket, Stepping Stones, Hi Lo Race
